MARKET OUTLOOK

Markets to get a positive start on sanguine regional cues: The Indian markets remained in jubilant mood and snapped the May series on strong note, with the major benchmarks soaring to their highs of the year in the last session. Some upbeat earnings and policy decisions coupled with short covering helped the markets post another big rally. Today, the start of the new series is likely to be in green and the markets will be extending the gains, though all eyes will be on the Fed chief's speech at Massachusetts on Friday night to look for clues to a rate hike.

EQUITY MARKET WRAP UP

Markets rally for the third day in a row; Nifty reclaims 8,000mark: The local equity markets rallied for the third day in a row on Thursday, as participants indulged in buying valuable stocks at attractive valuations. Sentiment got a boost after Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that he expects the long-pending GST bill to get the parliamentary nod this year while efforts to amend another contentious legislation on land acquisition are 'over now'. BSE Sensex surged 485.51 points or 1.88% to 26366.68, while the CNX Nifty rose 134.75 points or 1.7% to 8,069.65. The BSE Sensex touched a high and a low 26398.94 and 25941.51, respectively. The broader indices made a positive closing; the BSE Mid cap index ended up by 1%, while Small cap index gained 0.86%

- OTC trade data of government securities as on May 25: As per the OTC data of May 25, 8.07% GS 2017, maturing on 15-January-2017 was in maximum demand with 21 number of trades and total volume of Rs 1767.25 crore, at last traded price of Rs 100.45 and last traded YTM of Rs 7.31. Followed it was, 12.60% GS 2018, maturing on 23-November-2018 with 1 trades of total volume Rs 1250.00 crore, at last traded price of 111.95 and last traded YTM of Rs 7.27.
- Rupee rises for the second straight session: Indian rupee extended their gaining streak on Thursday, supported by the second consecutive day of rally in the local equity markets. The domestic currency that made a flat start picked up pace in the latter trade after the local equity market started moving higher . Rupee ended at 67.17, 16 paise stronger from its previous close at 67.33 on Wednesday. The currency touched a high and low of 67.60 and 67.31 respectively.
